Passports

- Ensure your passport is valid for **at least six months** from the date you intend to return to Australia.
- Carry copies of a recent passport photo in case you need a replacement passport while overseas.
- The Indonesian Government allows **visa-free short visits (30 days)** for Australians
- Non Australian passport holders, please check your individual requirements
