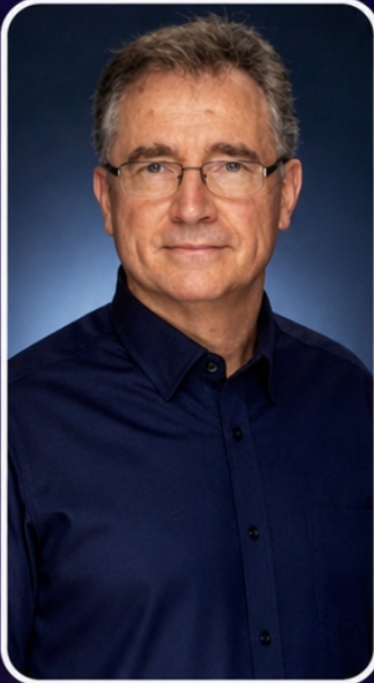

Meet the Keynote Speakers



Francois Burman

VP Safety Services, DAN

Francois Burman is the Vice President of Safety Services at Divers Alert Network (DAN), leading global initiatives in diving safety, emergency response, and medical support for divers worldwide. With a strong background in hyperbaric and diving medicine, he is widely recognised for advancing diver safety standards, incident management, and education.

He was one of two partners who restarted hyperbaric oxygen (HBO) services in South Africa's private sector in 1997, following his involvement in the engineering, building, and safety of these facilities since 1994. He also contributes to international standards through committees including NFPA 99 and PVHO.

Dr Jane Edgeloe

Marine Scientist & Discoverer of the World's Largest Plant

Dr Jane Edgeloe is a marine scientist and researcher, best known for her role in the discovery and identification of the world's largest known plant—a vast seagrass meadow located in Western Australia. Her work has gained international recognition for its significance in marine ecology and conservation.

She is passionate about protecting ocean ecosystems and advancing scientific understanding through innovative research, collaboration, and environmental stewardship.
